

Our Board of Trustees Academic Scholarship is an exceptional opportunity for high school seniors.

The Board of Trustees Academic Scholarship is valid toward one associate degree (A.A., A.S., or A.A.S.) and is renewable each academic semester. Recipients are eligible to receive a scholarship until they complete one associate degree, or 66 credits, or five (5) consecutive full-time semesters.

A total of twenty-one scholarships will be offered annually. Fourteen scholarships will be offered to students that are residents of Cambria County. Seven scholarships will be offered to Pennsylvania students from outside Cambria County. The value of this scholarship is \$1,000 per semester.

Application Process

1. Complete the College's application for admission and submit your high school transcripts.
2. Receive your acceptance letter with your computer account activation information, which includes your myPEAK username and password.
3. Access and complete the online scholarship application and essay using your username and password at PENNHIGHLANDS.AWARDSRING.COM. Because the scholarship system is integrated with student data, much of your information is stored in the application.

The application is available from October 1st through November 30th. Scholarships will be awarded after the Board of Trustees' January meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

- ✓ Be a high school senior eligible for graduation with a cumulative overall grade point average of at least 3.5.
- ✓ Be recognized as a good citizen of the high school community by being involved and demonstrating leadership in at least three extra-curricular activities.
- ✓ Complete the admissions process and be admitted to Pennsylvania Highlands.
- ✓ Complete and submit a Board of Trustees Academic Scholarship Application and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- ✓ Qualify for college-ready status in writing, reading, and math through the College's Placement Testing Policy and Waiver Guidelines.

Select candidates will be asked to participate in a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.

Online applications are due no later than November 30, 2019.

TERMS

The scholarship is applied to the cost of tuition; College fees, books, and materials are the responsibility of the student. Students will be monitored each semester to track academic progress, credit load, and eligibility.

The scholarship will be renewed each academic semester provided the following criteria are met:

- ✓ The student maintains a 3.25 grade point average and is enrolled full-time.
- ✓ The student successfully completes at least 27 college credits in an academic year.
- ✓ The student completes 10 hours per semester of participation in College-related services as defined by the Scholarship Committee.
- ✓ The student meets with an assigned scholarship mentor throughout the award period and attends scheduled meetings.

Representatives of the Student Services department will serve as scholarship mentors and chair the Scholarship Committee. Students may speak with their scholarship mentor regarding any unmet criteria.
